

## Information Statement – Retailer Energy Productivity Scheme (REPS)

### South Australia

In South Australia, the government's Retailer Energy Productivity Scheme (REPS) provides incentives for South Australian households and businesses to save energy.

Under REPS, energy retailers such as AGL have mandated annual targets for undertaking approved energy productivity activities, such as installing energy efficient products. These activities help improve energy productivity for households, businesses and the broader energy system.

Our Virtual Power Plant (VPP) is an approved REPS activity for residential VPP customers. We'll use the credits created by you joining our Virtual Power Plant towards our annual targets. In return, this allows us to increase the VPP credits (or further discount the upfront solar battery or solar battery bundle price, if applicable) for VPP customers in South Australia.
